AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE ASSOCIATION



1. To safeguard the health of mothers and babies.
2. To encourage the breast feeding of infants.
3. To equip and maintain a Hospital and Babies Home, and Infant Welfare and Mothercraft Training School, with Model Baby Health Centre for:
 - (a) The special training of Infant Welfare Sisters and Mothercraft Nurses.
 - (b) The provision of education for mothers with a view to enabling them to bring up their children in accordance with modern health principles.
 - (c) The provision of accommodation for the education and care of mothers and babies, especially nursing mothers, and for difficult, delicate or premature babies who may require special investigation and expert care in regard to their rearing, and so that where mothers in poor, necessitous or destitute circumstances are so accommodated and maintained, the Association shall contribute towards their upkeep from its funds received voluntarily for the purpose.
4. To co-operate with School and other authorities in giving teaching to classes of school girls and young women with the view of gaining their sympathy and interest in the proper care and nurture of babies and young children.
5. To arrange for organised teaching to women on the care of the—
 - (a) expectant mother,
 - (b) the mother, and
 - (c) children,and to disseminate such knowledge by every available means.
6. To co-operate with all present or future organisations working for the same objects.

FIFTY-FIRST ANNUAL REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is my pleasure to present to you the 51st Annual Report of the Victorian Baby Health Centres Association and its Queen Elizabeth Hospital for Mothers and Babies which is a Training School for Infant Welfare Sisters as well as Mothercraft Nurses, the Hospital also cares for Mothers needing help with the care and management of babies and young children, also Social Welfare Children.

A Model Baby Health Centre is conducted at 96 Keppel Street in conjunction with the Hospital.

ADMINISTRATION

The administration is carried out by an Executive Committee assisted by its Committee of Management and Finance. These Committees meet each month working in close co-operation with Matron Buxton and her Staff.

The Hospital is very fortunate in having interested Medical Personnel who act in an Honorary capacity whilst taking a keen interest in the Welfare Babies as well as the Hospital.

RETIREMENTS

Four Members of the Committee retired during the year after serving for a very long period. To Mr. and Mrs. Howard and Mr. and Mrs. Wang we say thank you very much for your generosity and long service and be assured of our best wishes.

GENERAL

After many months internal discussion and consultation with the Hospital and Charities Commission, the revised Constitution was submitted to Central Council for confirmation in September, then to the Commission for approval, which was granted.

The Kalamazoo system of bookkeeping is gradually being introduced. It is hoped this will be to our advantage in saving time and should be more efficient, although the cost of the stationery will be a little greater.

The sterilising room in Mothers Wing has been re-painted, also the Mothers Sitting Room.

The large steriliser in this wing sprang a leak and the costly repairs were met by the Pied Pipers Committee which also donated to the Hospital a very nice new refrigerator. This proved its value during last summer.

A Fete was held in the grounds on November 30th and this added \$1,000.00 to our funds.

The Hospital was represented at the Australian Hospitals Association Congress held in Sydney during August 1968.

Hospital fees were raised late in the year and we are now enjoying the benefits of this.

With assistance from the Hospital and Charities Commission a Thermal Fire Alarm system has been installed throughout the Hospital and Hall.

MATRON'S REPORT

During the year cases of colds and gastric infection were reported and were ably taken care of by Dr. Wadds.

Sister Stott returned from Long Service Leave on August 12th, 1968, and Matron commenced her Long Service Leave as from that date.

Dr. Helen Bryce has resigned from the Hospital Honorary Staff as she is going overseas, we extend to her our sincere thanks and appreciation for the work that she has done these past years.

Sisters McCarthy and Ogier gave lectures to a group of University Students from the Boyd Domestic College. Many other groups have visited the Hospital during the year and have been most interested in the Hospital activities.

The Committee was asked to consider having an extension bell to the telephone from the Nationwide Food Service Office to the kitchen, this was done, and it has saved the nursing staff a lot of valuable time.

The "Twin-O-Vac" Sucker has been donated by the Pied Pipers Committee and gives a much needed and efficient piece of equipment.

All members of the Nursing Staff expressed their enjoyment of the excellent Christmas dinner prepared by Chef Wally and his staff and they wish to convey their thanks to the Committee for making this possible.

Two Malayan student Dietitians from the Royal Children's Hospital were with the Hospital for one week.

A tiny baby was admitted from "Allambie", 18 weeks old, the baby was premature and weighed only 1½ pounds at birth; Dr. Balestock feels that the baby will benefit from the care and attention we were able to give her.

MOTHERCRAFT LECTURES

Mothercraft Lectures in Schools from the second term 1968 to first term 1969 inclusive, I instructed Mothercraft at 36 Schools. Eight hundred and eighty lectures were given to a total of 2,253 girls.

The standard of work in all schools was high, and conduct during lessons was excellent.

I believe it desirable, where possible, that Mothercraft instruction be given no later than 3rd form, because of the number of girls that leave school, to start work after completing this form.

Also, it appears that Mothercraft can be included at this level, without upsetting the school curriculum.

BABY HEALTH CENTRE QUEEN ELIZABETH HOSPITAL

The Sister-In-Charge, Sister P. Love, is on leave of absence whilst undertaking a post graduate course, which, it is felt will not only be to Sister's advantage but to the Hospital also. During Sister Love's absence the work has been very ably carried on by Sister Cash who is not only responsible for the routine running of the Centre but in addition for the practical training of the Infant Welfare trainees, also to some extent the Mothercraft Nurses who register with the Queen Elizabeth Hospital. Home visiting is carried out regularly in the district as well as monthly immunisation sessions.

Sister also assists the Doctor in charge of the Pre-Natal Clinic conducted weekly at the Centre by the Health Section of the Melbourne City Council.

HALL

The hall is now showing a small profit, due to increased hiring as well as raised fees, the cleaning costs have been considerably reduced, but we must soon face the fact that the Hall and Offices do need repairs and re-painting, the curtains all need to be re-taped, all this will more than take care of this years savings.

STATE GOVERNMENT

The Committee values the Government's continuance of the special grants to the Queen Elizabeth Infant Welfare Training School.

MUNICIPAL AND SHIRE COUNCILS

To the Melbourne City Council we express our gratitude for the free use of a room in which we hold the Council Meetings, also for the regular arrival of the Infant Welfare Subsidy each quarter.

To all the Municipal and Shire Councils for their donations which are so valuable to the training of Sisters who go out to take charge of Centres.

WASTE PAPER AND CARDBOARD APPEAL

The Hospital and the Association continue to benefit each quarter by contributions received from the sale of waste, the collection of which is carried out by the "Hospitals and Charities Paper and Cardboard Appeal Committee".

Once again we appeal to the public to save their waste paper for the collector from the "Hospital and Charities Paper and Cardboard Appeal" as it is rather a painless way of helping not only the Queen Elizabeth Hospital but all Hospitals.

FINANCE

The Council desires to thank all those who have so generously contributed financial support for its many Maternal and Child Welfare activities during the year. These donations have been of great benefit to the Association for without this support the Association could not carry on its work.

GENERAL

Two visits to the Minister of Health have been made during the year regarding the Hospital's finance, but to date there has been no positive result from these visits.

APPEAL

We were most grateful to our Patroness, Lady Delacombe who officially launched this Appeal at a Reception given at Government House.

Lady Curtis, Our President, organised a marvellous Ladies Committee to plan a great many functions which were well supported and most successful.

Mr. J. J. McFarlane kindly undertook the Chairmanship of the Appeal and worked very hard to make it a success. To these two very wonderful people the Hospital Committee extends congratulations and most sincere thanks for the time given up as well as the hard work which was put into all phases of the work for the Appeal.

To the many people who have supported us in this, we extend very sincere thanks and appreciation for their generosity.

Numbers of good people helped by lending their homes for meetings as well as functions, and to the Business people who placed venues for functions without cost we are deeply appreciative and grateful.

APPRECIATION

After a great many years of service to the Association on the accounting side, we received the resignation of Brettnall, Dale & Co., early in 1969, we extend sincere thanks to them for their valuable service.
